

## Golf Report 24<sup>th</sup> February 2020

Despite the continuing showers we were able to play our usual program of golf this week on the Nambucca Heads Island Golf Course. On **Thursday** 82 golfers played a Medley Single Stableford in three Divisions. Division 1 was won by Greg McCoy playing off 5 who scored 38 points to win from Tony White (4) of Bonville on 34 points. In Division 2 Dennis Ashton (15) scored 36 points to win from Chris Thorndike (13) on 33. Danny Fleming (20) had the highest score of the day 39 to win with Walter Bortoletto (25) coming second on 37.

Nearest the pins on the day went to David Ogilvy on the Ecomist 2<sup>nd</sup>, Hans Jansen on 5, Col Wormleaton on 7, Greg McCoy won the Subway prize on 8, Ray Meehan won the Pizza on 13 and Paul Ryan took Stu's ball on 15 as well as the Pro-pin on 18. Balls went to 28.

On **Saturday** a great field of 102 was boosted by the inclusion of 25 visitors playing in a Medley Single Stableford. Division 1 went to a visitor David Irish (12) with 38 points from Greg McCoy(5) on 37. Division 2 went to Steve Frost (15) on 38 followed by Lindsay Caspers (18) on 38. Dave Rosser (20) scored an impressive 41 to take Division 3 with Neil Duffus close behind on 39.

The day's nearest the pins went to Don Wills on 2, Tony White on 5, Greg McCoy on 7, Peter Farrell took 8, Shane Anderson won 13, Drew Glasson took 15 and Greg McCoy once again won the Pro-pin on 18.

A small field of 18 played a Mixed 4BBB Stableford on Sunday. The winning pair was Sue and Tony Seymour who scored 46 points which was good in the threatening weather with occasional drizzle. No one managed to get on the green for the NTPs.

This week we have the February Dolphin Day on Thursday and on Saturday a 4BBB Stableford which is also the qualifier for the Men's 4BBB Stableford Knockout.
